

AMARANTH - Grain Golden

(Amaranthus hypochondriacus)

Certified Organic

Certified Organic

Fast growing annual to 1.5 metres high. Green leaves eaten like spinach when young, produces a soft golden flower head when seeds mature. Seeds have a high protein content. Used in cereal. Sow Spring-Summer.

AMARANTH - Leaf (Amaranthus gangeticus) Certified Organic

Annual, grows to 1.5 metres, leaves and stems used like spinach. Sow Spring-Summer. High in protein, vitamins and minerals.

ARTICHOKE - Globe (Cynara scolymus) Grows to 1.5 metres, a prized delicacy. Used steamed, in casseroles and preserves. Fast growing, likes rich well drained soil. Sow Autumn, Winter, Spring.

BEAN - BUSH (Phaseolus vulgaris)

High yielding and rich in protein. Plant every 3 weeks for continuous supply. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Brown Beauty **Certified Organic**

Old variety, french strain, disease resistant.

- Butter Bush **Certified Organic**

Compact grower to 45cm, producing crop of yellow pods, black seed, stringless when picked young, good flavour.

Organic

Highly productive variety producing green flat beans that are stringless when young with a sweet crunchy texture. It gets to 60cm high producing an early crop that can be harvested continuously over 4-5 weeks depending on conditions.

- Hawkesbury Wonder Popular old stringless variety, produces over a long period, green

pods to 15cm long.

- Prestons **Certified Organic**

Old variety producing tasty, round green pods over a long period. Bushy plant to 45cm.

BEAN - CLIMBING (Phaseolus vulgaris)

Take up little room and yield over a long period, provide trellis. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Delgado Black Mexican **Certified Organic**

Climber to 2 metres, green pods, black seeds. Mature seeds used as dry bean, also useful as black dye.

- Epicure **Certified Organic** Epicure bean has long flat green pods to 20cm with nice flavour.

Stringless when young. Strong grower. Certified Organic Strong grower to 2 metre. Green stringless, good yields over a

long period. - Greek Bean **Certified Organic**

Strong growing variety, producing good crop of flat green, stringless pods to 15cm long.

- Kentucky Wonder **Certified Organic** Vigorous grower, producing green, fleshy, flat pods. Stringless

when young to 20cm, rust resistant.

- Lablab (Doliochos lablab) **Certified Organic**

Vigorous perennial in warm climates to 2.5 metres. Pods eaten steamed or boiled when young. Black seeds, excellent legume, ground cover & soil improver. Note: Fast growing, provide ample space. Leaves can irritate sensitive skin.

Certified Organic - Lazy Housewife Stringless bean to 2 metres, originating from Germany. Good flavour, heavy bearing, green flat pods to 20cm long.

- Purple King **Certified Organic** Flat purple pod to 18cm popular variety. Pods turn green when cooked. Adds colour and flavour to salads.

Certified Organic - Rice Bean

Dense spreading variety for ground cover or trellis. Good nitrogen fixer, green manure and soil improver. Small green pods eaten steamed. Suited to warm climates.

- Snake Bean Black (Vigna unguiculata) Certified Organic Strong grower, yields 45cm long pods of black seeds, eat fresh or cooked.
- Snake Bean Brown (Vigna unguiculata) Certified Organic Long, extra thin pods to 60cm, climber to 2 metres high, brown seeds. Use as for black snake bean.

- Snake Bean - Red Noodle Climber to 2 metres producing juicy red pods to 60cm long. Tender crunchy beans retain colour when cooked, prolific bearing.

- Wellington Wonder **Certified Organic** Flat green pods to 20cm. Prolific cropping, good flavour. Climbs to 2 metres.

- Zebra **Certified Organic** Stringless pods when picked young, strong grower, old variety.

BEETROOT (Beta vulgaris)

Popular root vegetable, fast growing, bi-annual, easy to grow. Sow direct in garden, 60 days to maturity. Keep moist in fertile well drained soil. Use in salads, cooked or preserved. Sow all year except in hot weather.

- Detroit - Red **Certified Organic** Round red roots to 12cm across. Smooth, tender, sweet flavour.

Certified Organic

Also known as Candy Stripe. Attractive red skinned beetroot with red & white rings.

BOK CHOY - Chinese Cabbage (Brassica rapa) Certified Organic Annual loose cabbage with large green leaves & crunchy white stems. Harvest large leaves over a long period. Sow Autumn-Spring.

BROCCOLI (Brassica oleracea)

Rich in calcium, vitamins and minerals. Sow all year except hot weather.

- Albert **Certified Organic**

Compact plant, dark green medium sized heads. Produces many side shoots suitable for broccolini.

- Calabrese **Organic**

Good producer of medium sized heads & continues to produce side shoots once main head is harvested. - DiCicco

Certified Organic Compact Italian variety. Blue-green heads to 10cm across, produces over a long period. Harvest at 60 days.

Certified Organic - Umpqua

Heavy bearing variety with a high quality main head then ample side shoots for multiple weeks. Leaves can be eaten when young in salads or lighly blanched. Available November 2022

BROOM MILLET (Sorghum bicolor) **Certified Organic**

Tall grass like annual to 3 metres. Decorative straw like flower. Seed heads used to make brooms. Sow Spring-Summer.

CABBAGE (Brassica oleracea)

Popular vegetable, high in calcium and iron. Likes fertile well drained soil, sunny position, frost hardy. Sow all year, except hot conditions.

- Green Express **Certified Organic**

Early producing variety, forming small tight green heads to 1.5kg. 60 days to maturity from transplant. Likes fertile, well drained soil, sunny position, frost hardy. Compact variety that can be spaced 35cm apart. Sow all year except in hot conditions.

- Red **Certified Organic** Medium sized. Adds attractive colour to salads.

CAPSICUM (Capsicum annuum)

Popular Summer vegetable, high yielding, shrubby plants for warm sunny position. Yield over a long period. Sow Spring - Summer.

- Californian Wonder Sweet fruit, cube shaped 10 cm, bell type, heavy producer use green or red, high in Vitamin C.

- Mixed Colours Certified Organic

A colour mix of Red, Green, Golden & Chocolate. Needing similar growing conditions. Grows to 60cm high, Full sun well drained fertile position. Sow Spring-Summer.

- **Diamond**Certified Organic

Small white diamond shaped fruit, produced in abundance.

Capsicum changes from white to light orange on maturity.

- Golden Californian Wonder Certified Organic Compact bush to 60cm high, sweet capsicum to 10cm, block shape fruit, green ripening to yellow-gold. Adds colour to salads and cooked dishes.

- Jimmy Nardello Certified Organic Heavy producing Italian variety, long red sweet fruit to 25cm. Continuous cropper, excellent taste, great for stuffing. Popular Summer vegetable, high yielding, shrubby plant for warm sunny position. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Peperone Certified Organic Long thin and crinkly fruit with the aroma of a chilli but usually no heat when eaten. Stores well and can be harvested green to red. Grows to 60cm high, Full sun well drained fertile position. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Purple Beauty Certified Organic Compact bush to 45cm high, fruit 13cm long and 8cm wide. Green fruit, turning deep purple to red when mature.

- Sweet Chocolate Certified Organic Heavy producing variety with 15cm x 8cm green fruit ripening to a dark chocolate colour with brown-red flesh inside. Produces over a long period.

CARROT (Daucus carota)

Popular root vegetable, for deep well drained soil, sunny position. Do not over feed, keep moist. Sow All Year.

- Danvers

Hardy variety to suit most soils. Slender, deep orange colour to 15cm long, tolerates hot conditions. Eat fresh. Suited to freezing. Popular root vegetable, for deep well drained soil. Sunny position. Sow all year.

- Scarlet Nantes

Certified Organic
Fast producing variety with bright orange-red root to 18cm

Fast producing variety with bright orange-red root to 18cm, coreless variety. Very sweet flavour. Good for juicing and baby carrots.

- Western Red Certified Organic Long tapering root, smooth deep orange colour. Disease resistant. 70 days to maturity.

CELERY (Apium graveolens var dulce) Sow Autumn-Spring.

- Chinese (*Brassica juncea*) Certified Organic Grows to 60 cm, with large spicy flavoured leaves, 3-4 cm wide midrib & tapered at the end. Midrib is crunchy, juicy & sweet, can be eaten fresh or cooked.

- Red Stem Certified Organic Compact habit with thin stalks that colour to a reddish purple. Good flavour. Use stalks and leaves fresh when required.

- Tall Utah Certified Organic

Dark green stringless stems to 70cm.

- Tendercrisp Certified Organic Likes rich well drained soil and ample water. Green smooth stringless, very hardy.

CHIA (Salvia rhyacophila) Certified Organic
Hardy annual to 1.5 metres, leaves used in salads, seeds for sprouts

Hardy annual to 1.5 metres, leaves used in salads, seeds for sprouts. Seeds rich in vitamins and protein, forage plant. Whole plant regarded as survival food. Sow Spring-Summer.

Chicory (Chichorium intybus) Sow Autumn-Spring.

- Sugarloaf Certified Organic
Forming a large elongated head with dense green outer leaves
and a pale yellow centre. Bittersweet walnut like flavour. Sow
Autumn-Spring

COWPEA - Edible Giant (*Vigna unguiculata*) **Certified Organic** Annual legume spreading to 1.5 metres, mauve flowers. Green pods eaten when young, plants can yield up to 1kg of black seeds. Used cooked as for pulses, soil improver. Sow Spring - Summer.

CHILLI (Capsicum annuun)

Hardy Summer vegetable, high yielding. Adds flavour to cooked dishes. Ideal for bottling. Sow Spring-Summer, plant in good, well drained soil in sunny position. Sow Spring - Summer.

- Aji Limon (*Capsicum baccatum*) Certified Organic Popular annual to 90cm, producing yellow chillies to 6cm long. Originating from Peru. Heat Level: 5/10 Use fresh or dried. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.
- Bell (Capsicum baccatum) Certified Organic Grows to 80cm, colourful lantern shaped fruit. Green ripening to red. Ornamental specimen, South American species. Heat level 6/10.
- Cayenne (Capsicum annuum) Certified Organic Slender fruit to 10cm long, green turning to red. Medium heat, level 6/10.
- Explosive Ember (Capsicum annuum) Certified Organic Popular annual to 45cm, producing small purple/red chillies to 3cm long. Ideal in pots. Heat level 6/10. Use fresh or dried. Perfect for growing in pots. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.
- Fatalii (Capsicum chinense) Certified Organic Popular annual to 1m, producing tubular golden chillies to 6cm long. Heat level 10/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray
- Fiesta (Capsicum annuum) Certified Organic Compact low spreading ground cover. Fruit 9cm long, changing from cream/purple to orange then red. Heat level 5/10. Ideal to plant in pots or garden.
- -Habanero-Chocolate (*Capsicum chinense*) Certified Organic Fruit ripens from green to chocolate brown, measuring up to 6cm long & 2.5cm wide with waxy coating. Flavour rich, fruity, smokey. Grow up to 90cm high. Heat level 9/10.
- Habanero Orange (*Capsicum chinense*) Certified Organic Compact plant to 60cm high. Bright orange coloured fruit to 5cm long. Hot fruity flavour. Heat level 8/10.
- Habanero Red (Capsicum chinense) Certified Organic Bushing plant growing to 1 metre. Fruit are a glossy red getting to 4cm across. Will fruit in pots but much larger yields will be achieved in the garden. Heat Level 6/10
- Habanero White (Capsicum chinense) Certified Organic Popular annual to 80cm, producing masses of elongated white fruit to 3cm long. Originates from Peru. Heat level 8/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for spicy cooked foods, sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.
- Hot Thai (*Capsicum annuum*) Certified Organic Popular annual to 60cm, producing plenty of narrow red chilli's to 7cm long. Originates from Thailand, used in red currys. Heat level 8/10. Use fresh or dried.
- Jalapeno Certified Organic Popular variety, fruit red or green, hot, 8cm long, thick flesh, original Mexican chillies. Heat level 4/10.
- Paprika (*Capsicum annuum*) Certified Organic Narrow red fruits to 8cm long. Dried & ground into powder or use as mild chillies. Heat level 2/10.
- Yellow Jelly Bean (*Capsicum chinense*) Certified Organic Popular annual to 1m, producing powerful yellow fruit to 1cm long. Heat level 9/10. Use fresh or dried. Ideal for adding spice in sauces, bottling & insecticidal spray.

CORN (Zea mays) - Not to TAS -

Popular easy to grow. For fertile, well drained soil, sunny position. Pick your own fresh corn. Sow Spring - Summer.

<u>Maiz</u>

- Early LeamingTall heritage variety to 3 metres. Long cob to 25cm, yellow kernels, eaten when young or stock feed.

Manning Pride Organic

Rare heirloom variety that was bred in the Manning Valley from Manning White. Large cob to 20cm long with large golden kernels, cobs can be eaten fresh or stored dried for animal feed. Despite being a maize Manning Pride is an excellent 'sweet corn' when young with a sweet creamy texture.

- Manning White **Certified Organic**

Tall grower to 3 metres, producing 1 large cob of white corn. Eat fresh or use as animal feed. Bred in the Manning Valley 1932.

- Silvermine

A rare dent corn used for feed production. Producing 1-2 large 23cm cobs of white corn. Kernels are deep on average 15mm. Strain may have history with Manning Silvermine but it's hard to be certain. Eat cobs roasted at milking stage or for animal feed. Easy to grow. Sunny position.

Popcorn

- Blue Mini Organic

Highly sought after heirloom popcorn variety. Growing to 1.5m they will not take up to much room in your garden. Pop's extremely well. 90 days to maturity.

- Strawberry Mini **Certified Organic**

Fast growing to 1.2 metres high, producing up to 6 cobs per plant with bright red kernals. Ideal for popcorn or crafty creations.

Sweet Corn

- Anasazi **Certified Organic**

Ancient multi-coloured sweet corn. Derived from the Anasazi Indians in America. Beautiful eating corn. Maturity 90 days.

- Hawaiian **Certified Organic**

Compact grower to 1.5m. Produces 2 good sized delicious yellow cobs. Good flavour. 100 days to maturity.

Certified Organic

Strong grower to 3m, producing 2 good sized yellow cobs per plant. Harvest young for good flavour. 110 days to maturity.

- Golden Bantam **Certified Organic**

Popular variety producing up to 2 yellow cobs per plant, early maturing 70-80 days. Good flavour.

CUCUMBER (Cucumis sativus)

Summer salad vegetable likes rich well watered soil. Sow Spring - Summer.

- African Horned (Cucumis metuliferus) Certified Organic Fruit 15cm long, spiny skin, orange at maturity. Sweet green jelly-like flesh inside. Four times the Vitamin C of oranges.

- German Pickling

Compact spreading vine, producing yellow tinged fruit, pick at 20cm. Juicy and crisp eaten fresh, pick at young stage for pickling.

- Giant Russian

Vigorous mildew resistant variety, acid free. Crisp sweet flesh, eat at 20cm long. Good keeper. - Lebanese Certified Organic Compact bush variety. Fruit picked at 20cm, green colour, good flavour, non acid. For home gardens and commercial growers.

- Lebanese **Certified Organic** Compact bush variety. Fruit picked at 20cm, green colour, good

flavour, non acid. For home gardens and commercial growers.

- Long White **Certified Organic**

Long white fruit to 18 cm, very tasty. Early season. Low-acid.

- Marketmore

Popular variety. Flavoured green fruit to 25cm long. Good producer.

- White Spine **Certified Organic**

Smooth white skin, oblong fruit to 15cm. Good flavour, excellent eating.

- West Indian Gherkin (Cucumis anguria) **Certified Organic** Produces green 5 cm diameter fruits, soft spines on outside, sweet and juicy when young. Used for pickling. Eat fresh.

EGGPLANT (Solanum melongena)

Attractive leaves and flowers. Fruit used in cooked dishes. Sow Spring-Summer. Likes fertile well drained soil in sunny position

- Black Beauty **Organic**

Decorative annual, attractive leaves and flowers. Fruit used in cooking. Large oval black fruit. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Long Purple **Organic**

Popular variety, producing long dark fruit to 25cm long and 8cm wide. Good cropper.

Certified Organic

An elongated white eggplant that has a nice smooth texture and milder flavour. Easy to grow and large producer. Fruits are 12cm x 6cm in size.

- Thai Pea (Solanum torvum)

Certified Organic

Shrubby plant, perennial to 90cm high & wide. Branching habit, green pea sized berries produced in clusters, have a slightly bitter taste. Used in Thai dishes. Frost tender, sow Spring-Summer.

- Tsakoniki

Bushy plant to 70cm high. Fruit purple with white stripes, cylindrical up to 25cm long.

GOURD (Lagenaria siceraria)

Eaten like squash & zucchini when picked young. Many shaped fruits. Dried fruits can be decorated and used for bowls and musical instruments. Sow Spring-Summer.

- Ancient **Certified Organic**

Vigorous vine, provide large support to climb on. Large trombone shape fruit.

- Large Mixed **Certified Organic**

Vigorous vine, as above. Large white flowers.

- New Guinea Certified Organic Also known as New Guinea bean. Annual vine grown on fence

or ground. Long smooth, pale green fruits to 1.3 metres long. Harvest fruits at 20cm & use like zucchini. Used in Indian & Asian dishes.

- Snake (Trichosanthes anguina) **Certified Organic** Vigorous climbing annual. Mature fruit to 1 metre long with decorative hard shell.

KOHLRABI - Azur Star (Brassica oleracea) Certified Organic

A delicious purple bulbing vegetable perfect for baking, grated or steamed. Peel outer skin off before eating inner flesh. Bulb is round with a slightly flat appearance - up to 7cm across. Harvest after 60 days. Leaves can also be used similar to kale and best eaten when young. Sow Autumn-Spring.

KOHLRABI - Purple Vienna (Brassica oleracea) Organic Fast growing vegetable, bulb & stem are purple. Sweet flesh is white, delicious steamed. Sow Autumn - Spring.

Leek (Allium ampeloprasum porrum)

Great steamed, baked, fried for garnish, boiled, blends well with other vegetables. Adds flavour to soups & quiches. Likes deep, fertile, moist soil. Sow Autumn - Winter.

- Autumn Giant Certified Organic

Large grower with a thick stem. Tender stem which is perfect when cooked.

Certified Organic - Carentan

European heirloom leek variety with thick stems up to 5cm wide. Matured in 100 days.

LETTUCE (Lactuca sativa)

Hearting and loose leaf types, decorative colours and shapes. For Cool/Cold climates sow Spring-Autumn. All other climates sow Autumn-Spring. Varieties available for all seasons, plant in rich well drained soil, sunny moist position.

- Australian Yellow Certified Organic

Wavy loose leaf head with yellowish green glow in colour.

- Brown Romaine **Certified Organic** Loose leaf type. Green and brown tinge. Heat resistant.

Certified Organic - Buttercrunch Small dark green crisp head with fan shaped leaves, heat resistant variety.

- Cos Paris Island **Certified Organic**

Soft green cos variety with pale cream inside, semi hearting. Ideal to pick as baby leaf, excellent flavour & texture for salad mix.

- Cos Red **Certified Organic**

Romaine type. Dark red leaves, highly attractive, pick leaves as required.

- Cos Verdi **Certified Organic**

Open, upright hearting variety, crisp leaves with smooth edges, unique sweet taste.

- Everlasting **Certified Organic**

Loose leaf type, leaves are light green and dissected. - Four Seasons **Certified Organic**

Compact hearting variety that can still be side picked. Red leaves with excellent buttery texture.

- Freckles **Certified Organic**

Loose green leaf type, broad flat leaves with an ornamental fleck or red spots on the leaves.

- Frilly Pink **Certified Organic**

Non-hearting, open leaf type. Large green leaves with attractive pink edges.

- Green Mignonette **Certified Organic** Popular compact hearting variety. Soft green leaves with sweet flavour.

- Green Oak **Certified Organic** Green open leaf type. Leaves are oak shaped.

- Green Salad Bowl **Certified Organic** Soft green frilly leaf ideal for side picking. Continual harvest during Autumn/winter.

- Red Mignonette **Certified Organic** Compact hearting variety. Soft red/brown leaves with a sweet flavour.

- Red Oak Leaf **Certified Organic** Annual leafy green to 30cm, non-hearting. Leaves red tinged and dissected.

- Red Salad Bowl **Certified Organic** Decorative variety that adds colour to salads or use as a garnish. Leaves are bronze/red, dissected and wavy. Harvest as a side pick variety or cut whole plant.

- Ricciolina da Taglio **Certified Organic** Loose leaf variety with green deeply lobed curly leaves. Pick as required.

- Side Pick **Certified Organic** Frilly green dissected leaves. Light green colour. Highly decorative loose leaf type.

- Summer Mix Mix of Lettuce Brown Romaine, Frilly Pink and Riccolina da Taglio. All varieties are more suitable to the summer heat. Harvest the outside leaves after 6 weeks continuously.

- Summer Queen **Certified Organic** Large grower with a small green head and side leaves can be

picked as needed. Handles early and late summer conditions with improved bolt resistance. 60 days to maturity.

LUFFA (Luffa aegyptiaca) **Certified Organic**

Train on trellis, large yellow flowers. Bathroom sponge and scrubber. Eat like marrow when young. Sow after frost.

MESCLUN MIX - Lettuce Organic

A mixture of green & red lettuce varieties. Ideal for picking fresh leaves from a young to mature stage.

The varieties listed below have many uses in providing mulch, nitrogen fixation to the soil, organic matter which can be slashed or turned in and also providing a broad range of nutrients.

Legumes can be sown on their own or with existing vegetation. We recommend with low fertility soils that some type of nutrients be added initially in an organic form to help the green manure along. Grasses and grains can be grown on their own if fertility is good, thus providing bulk organic matter when slashed.

GREEN MANURE MIX

Organic

A mix of seeds for specific seasons. This mix provides variety in your green manure. Specify season; Autumn/Winter - Buckwheat, Chickpea, Rye mix. Spring/Summer - Mungbean, Sunflower & Millet. 500gm will cover 30m².
